Abstract:

This collection encompasses the workings of the Whitehouse Station Business Association. Much of the organization's emphasis involved planning the annual Memorial Day Parade in Whitehouse Station. There are a series of folders that review the annual activities of the historical society. A wide variety of Administrative Records are available which include public relations, finances and event planning. There is also documentation available entailing the design and construction of the Veteran's Monument that stands today at the Readington Municipal Building. Many folders of the collection contain documentation showing the correspondence between the public, government officials, government organizations and private business.

ORGANIZATIONAL NOTES:

There are a series of different folders that overview several aspects of the society. There are a series of folders that focus on annual event planning. A second series of folders go into the daily operations of the society. It is interesting to note the coordination and cooperation that was needed between private business, government entities and the general public. All of these organizations are needed in order for the Business Association to successfully function. Much of the information involved in this collection was during the time period of 1970s. All of the information contained in this collection focuses strictly on Whitehouse Station, New Jersey.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

This collection is divided into two series. The first series deals with the annual event planning functions of the Business Association. This series has several folders which focus on each year of event planning. The date range of the event plans runs from 1969 through 1979.

The second series is a review of the Administrative Functions of the Business Association. A series of folders reviews different administrative aspects which include policy, membership, business records and public relations.
