Abstract	This collection is comprised of documents relating to the tavern license, tax receipts and tavern costs for a tavern or inn operated by Moses Lake, at his home in Raritan Township, NJ.
Scope and Content	In 1863 Moses Lake received a liquor license and paid taxes required to operate an Inn or Tavern at his home. The portion of the license containing the date granted and date of expiration has been torn off. Included in the collections is a document stating the Rules and Prices charged for Man and Horse by every licensed Inn-holder and Tavern-Keeper in Flemington, NJ. This was enacted February 24, 1797 and was signed by the Court Clerk Alpaugh, in 1863.
