Abstract	A small collection of Christmas cards from Mr. and Mrs. Green to Ms. Vaiculevich's mother, who worked for them at the time of receipt of the cards, as well as four photographs; a portrait of Mr. and Mrs. Green, individually, and a single photograph of each with their horses.
Biographic Notes	Mr. and Mrs. Green were a prominent couple in Flemington during the 1930s and 1940, most likely before and after as well. Mr. Green owned the Green Building on Main Street that housed his pharmacy. Mrs. Green was a locally prominent photographer who took photos during the trail of Bruno Hauptman, which is now known as the Lindbergh Trial.
Scope and Content	This collection provides a glimpse into the personal lives of Mr. and Mrs. Green from 1938 intermittently to 1946 through the Christmas cards they sent to their staff and friends. The cards contain reprints of photographs of their pets, home, and horses. Cards of this type were not typical of holiday cards sent during this time period, and include one card with an artificial composition. Two cards have religious themes.  The photographs are two portraits, of Mr. and Mrs. Green separately. There is also a personal photograph of each with their horses.
