Abstract:	The collection comprises 1 handwritten lease of Eliza Large for a property in Whitehouse Station and 61 various photographs. The photographs date from approximately 1865 to 1920 and include various photographic processes such as ferrotype, albumen, silver gelatin, and developed out prints. Photographic studios represented include Sunderlin of Flemington, Pank of Lambertville and Clarke of New Brunswick. Unfortunately, most of the subjects are unidentified.
BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES:	 George Hall Large (December 1, 1850 – August 15, 1939) was an American lawyer and Republican Party politician who served as President of the New Jersey Senate. He was also the longest surviving participant in the first ever college football game in 1869. Large married the former Josephine Ramsey on November 15, 1877, and she died not long before their sixtieth anniversary, on January 5, 1937. They had three children: George Knowles (born February 3, 1879), Edwin Kirk (born August 14, 1880), and Helen Brokaw (born August 12, 1889). George K. Large served as judge of the Hunterdon County Court of Common Pleas and was an assistant prosecutor in
	County Court of Common Pleas and was an assistant prosecutor in the Lindbergh kidnapping trial. Edwin K. Large served as postmaster of Atlanta, Georgia.
SCOPE AND CONTENT	The Large Photographs consist of: (i) a handwritten form lease of Eliza Large and (ii) 61 photographs. The collection would be useful to anyone researching the Large family or photographs taken during

the second half of the $19^{\mbox{\tiny th}}$ century and early part of the 20th.
