Abstract:

Collection consists of twenty-three assorted photographs of scenes from the trial of Bruno Hauptman. The photographs do not provide complete coverage of the trial but give a general overview of different events surrounding, and within, the courthouse. The photographer is unknown.

Content Notes:

The infant son of Charles Lindbergh, Charles Lindbergh Jr., was kidnapped from the bedroom of the family home in Hopewell, NJ on March 1, 1932. His body was discovered on May 12, 1932. Bruno Hauptman, a carpenter born in Germany, was charged with the kidnapping based on evidence of a car license plate, gold coins, handwriting analysis and wood matching the ladder that was used to access the bedroom window. The trial ran from January 1, 1935 through February 13, 1935 at the County Courthouse in Flemington, NJ and was the original õtrial of the centuryö in the United States. Bruno Hauptmann was convicted of the crime and was executed on April 3, 1936.

Scope and Content:

The twenty-three photographs depict scenes outside the courthouse of the lead defense attorney Edward J. Reilly, Reilly and Hauptman at the defense table, the wooden ladder and of Charles Lindbergh Sr. entering the courtroom. No further information concerning the origin of these photographs is available, as they were acquired by the Society through purchase from a local antique dealer.
