## Scope & Content / Abstract:

Abstract: This collection is comprised of documents relating to the service records and biographical information concerning Hunterdon County Revolutionary War soldiers. The folders are a mix of original notes, research, and copies of information from other primary and secondary sources. The collection would interest anyone conducting biographical or genealogical research on Hunterdon County Revolutionary War Soldiers.

Scope and Content: This collection is arranged in 36 folders of documents in two containers. Each folder (except the first folder of background information) is a file that contains notes on one soldier and his family. The folders contain service records, war pension applications and records, family genealogical notes, and in some cases wills, obituaries, grave site information, and news clippings. The folders are arranged alphabetically but are also numbered according to the container list for ease of access.

## Context:

Administrative / Biographical history: In 1975, an article appeared in the Hunterdon Historical Newsletter, Vol. 11, No. 3, Page 10. Entitled "Hunterdon's Last Veterans of the Revolutionary War," the article solicited information about the life and records of the soldiers in the list.

These files are believed to be the results, probably combined with internal notes and research on each soldier. The files on each soldier were used to write a series of biographical articles in subsequent newsletter issues that highlighted the service and lives of some of the men listed in the original article. The articles are still available to researchers in back issues of the Society's newsletters, but the raw data in its collection form should still be of value to anyone researching these soldier's lives.
