Abstract: The Van Fleet Collection consists of thirteen (13) day books, also

known as business ledgers. They cover the time period from 1868 thru 1899 while the Readington Steam Mill operated, and later when the building was used as a store. The Mill was owned and operated by John Van Fleet, and later included participation by D.G. Thomas.

Also included are three (3) ledgers documenting the business activities of Jacob Van Fleet, the son of John, while working as a

barber.

BIOGRAPHICAL

NOTES:

This collection was donated by Harold Van Fleet, great-great nephew of John Van Fleet and distant cousin of Jacob Van Fleet. John Van Fleet was the proprietor and manager of the Readington Steam Mill. Mill Books document a partnership with D.G. Thomas. Jacob Van Fleet, John's son, was a barber in Readington.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection contains 13 day books and one letter. John Van Fleet was the proprietor and manager of the Readington Steam Mill; his day books contain information concerning customers, purchases, inventories, 'bags lent out' and staff information. Thirteen of the books document the activities at the mill. Two of the books document the accounts and sales while the building was a store. John Van Fleet's son, Jacob worked as a barber and provides three books documenting the activities of his barber shop. The letter was received by John Van Fleet from A. Leod regarding syrup.
