The bulk of the collection is comprised of programs from the decade of the 1950's. There are also some examples of subscriptions, tickets, and admission cards. This collection would be of particular interest to anyone researching Hunterdon County music history or institutions of the 1950's.

Administrative / Biographical history: The Hunterdon County Symphony Orchestra started at the Clinton Presbyterian men's club in the fall of 1949. Eighteen musicians of the North Hunterdon area were invited by the men's group to play at their meetings. The musicians were directed by Mr. Reynolds Happe. They gave two performances for the men's club, two for churches and another for the medical center. A year later they branched off from the men's club and became an independent organization. This collection shows their success playing all over Hunterdon County.

[Note: This group, the Hunterdon County Symphony Orchestra, is not the same organization as that which is active today in hunterdon County in 2014.]
