Context:

Dates of accumulation: 1929-1941

Administrative / Biographical history: The Archeological Society of New Jersey was consituted on November 12, 1931. The main objective is to support the preservation of significant archeological sites and artifacts. In 1934, the society was one of the founding members to organize the Eastern States Archeological Federation which carries out interstate projects east of the mississippi rivers. The society publishes bulletins and scientific articles written by professionals and amateurs. The Newsletters have notes of current activities of archeological interest.

Custodial history: This particular set of Society papers were the property of Hiram E. Deats, a Hunterdon County member of the NJ Archaeological Society. Mr. Deats had an abiding interest in archeaology and in collecting Native American artifacts. These papers, part of a larger bequest of papers Mr. Deats made to the Hunterdon County Historical Society, were distinctly separated and organized into this sub-grouping by him and so are presented as a unique collection.
