## Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection is comprised of records and photographs that document the Dilts family, the Saums and Cole farms, and schools, churches, and theatres in the Voorhees Corner/Three Bridges region of Hunterdon County, NJ.

The collection is contains 13 folders. The first two folders contain church and theatre programs from local institutions. Another folder contains records of Theodore Dilts. There is a series of photographs that capture the Saums and Cole farms, as well as the new highway bridge (ca. 1934) over Rt. 202 (then Rt. 29). Finally, there are several images of the Three Bridges and Voorhees Corner Schools with students. The image of the Voorhees Corner School is of particular interest since it is dated (1912) and identifies every subject in the photograph.

Administrative / Biographical history: This collection was donated by Robert Cole of Readington Township, NJ. The materials are handed down from branches of his family including the Coles, Potts, and Saums families; the records are predominantly from Readington and Raritan Townships.
