Scope & Content / Abstract:

Abstract: This collection features two baseball scorebooks that were used by the Milford Athletic Association. The scorebooks were used for the 1919 and 1921 baseball seasons. This collection is a great resource for anyone who was interested in local sports and researching local community involvement.

Scope and Context: During the 1919 and 1921 summer baseball season scorebooks were kept by the Milford, NJ team. The baseball season lasted from Late-May through Mid-September. Each season was 24 games long. The Milford team matched up against many local teams around the Hunterdon County area but also expanded into neighboring communities which included Easton, Phillipsburg and Doylestown. The score was kept for each game with the team roster being listed. The final item is a clipping from a newspaper article highlighting the top performers during the 1919 season.
