Scope & Content / Abstract:**Abstract:**

This collection contains the genealogical and historical research, writing notes, drafts, and publication notes for a self-published book completed in 2002 by Edward Cohen, entitled "Lambertville's Legacy."

Scope and Content:

This collection is arranged to be consistent with the process of publishing a book. There are four boxes in the collection.

The 1st box contains research and production files.

The 2nd box contains research books and sources, photographs of the author Edward Cohen, photograph negatives of images used in the publication, and floppy diskettes with electronic versions of research and writing.

The 3rd box contains grant letters for publication, draft copies of "Lambertville's Legacy" and 1 final copy.

The 4th box contains a copy of the book referred to as a "clean copy" of "Lambertville's Legacy." The box also includes correspondence congratulating him on the publication of the work, and the collection concludes with notes on Coryell family genealogy.
