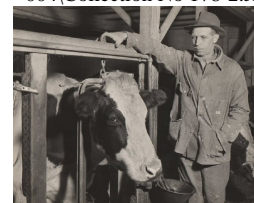

Title: Harold B. Everitt Papers

Scope & Content / Abstract:

1 Box. Harold B. Everitt Papers. This one box collection contains 12 folders and is comprised of newspapers, periodicals, brochures, farm conservation plans, and photographs relating to the agricultural and civic activities of Harold B. Everitt, and the Everitt farm of Hunterdon County, NJ circa 1900-1980. Finally, one folder contains a photograph of Mr. Steward Gordon, a music teacher at the Flemington School, at his retirement.

Context:

Administrative / Biographical history: Harold B. Everitt, born ca. 1892 in Hunterdon County, son of Abel and Laura(Hann) Everitt, lived in Raritan Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on May 10, 1983 at home at the age of 91. His wife, Alberta (Polhemus) Everitt died in 1976. He was survived by a daughter, Ruth Wieland of Philadelphia. Mr. Everitt was a member of the Hunterdon County Board of Agriculture, a Raritan Township tax assessor for 37 years, and the registrar of vital statistics for even more years.
