Title: Lebanon Township Notes to Assessor
 Extent of the unit of description: 1 box; .25 linear feet

Scope & Content / Abstract:

This small collection consists of real estate transfer notices to the Lebanon Township tax assessor dated 1921-1930 indicating new and previous owners of properties, surveyor's notes of boundaries, significant landmarks, and current (and sometimes, prior) adjacent owners. It would interest researchers of Lebanon Township property in the decade of the 1920's.

Context:

Name of Creator: C. Lloyd Fell

Administrative / Biographical history: Notices to Assessors are documents created by the County Clerk. They document a change of ownership of a taxable property during a fiscal year, and they are delivered to the Tax Assessor of the municipality in which the change of ownership took place. While narrow in scope, they can be very important to those researching the history or title of that particular property. In aggregate, they can provide data for statistical studies.

Sometimes the notice will contain additional information, such as surveyor's notes or adjacent ownership that can be helpful for research purposes.
