Identity Statement:

Title: Bertha Schuck Collection
Extent of the unit of description: 1 Box; .25 linear feet.

Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection includes a grouping of materials assembled by Bertha Schuck, of Stockton, NJ. There are some personal documents, but most of the collection includes published materials concerning Stockton, NJ, surrounding municipalities, and church and other organizations nearby. Documents include personal correspondence, newspaper clippings concerning a proposed quarry at Goat Hill, Lutheran and other church related items, notices and clippings from various municipalities, Delaware Senior Citizen Club records, and Hunterdon County Park maps.

Interestingly, there is another group of items in the collection: a listing of typhoid shot recipients of 1955 from Stockton and surrounding townships. Due to Federal Health Records and Patient Privacy laws, this folder of materials must remain closed to researcher until 2055.

Although there is little personal material here, the collection does reflect the concerns of a few interested parties at various points in the history of Stockton and Hunterdon County, and it documents a select few subjects during that time frame.
