**Scope & Content / Abstract:**

Abstract: This collection consists of 12 containers of correspondence, photographs, documents, manuscripts, ledgers, pamphlets, financial documents, reports, brochures, programs, and other materials relating to the founding and governance of Franklin Township, Hunterdon County, NJ, and its civic and social activities. The collection will interest researchers of Franklin Township and Hunterdon County in general.

Scope and Content: 12 Boxes of Historic Records from Franklin Township, NJ. Records are courtesy of the Franklin Archives, of the Rural Awareness Committee, Inc., a non-profit corporation founded "to preserve the history and rural character of Franklin Township."

The collection includes but is not limited to:

Corporate and clerk's records from Franklin Township, NJ, including founding documents, township committee records, commemorative event programs, photographs, scrapbooks, and journals, Rural Awareness, Inc. corporate and founding documents, Franklin Township PTA Records, historical programs and brochures, and other historically important documents and ephemera.

These documents are significant because they represent the founding and governance of Franklin Township, as well as providing a snapshot of the natural history, commerce, civic and cultural activities of the community.
