**Scope & Content / Abstract:**

This collection consists of 7 photographs of Flemington, NJ, 1937-1939, with highly detailed information on the verso. Includes street scenes and landscapes.

These photographs appear to be centered around the vicinity of Park Avenue in Flemington, New Jersey and reflect what some properties looked like ca. 1937-1939. The Auction Market building is highlighted, and frequent mention is made of Hoffman Seed Company in the details on the verso. Many residents are mentioned by name and some details are provided for the location of various residences and businesses in that neighborhood. Although small, this collection is particularly interesting because the views are from the rear of Main Street, showing details not often visible in other photographic collections.
