Identity Statement:

Title: The Family Casket Collection
Extent of the unit of description: 1 box; 2.5 linear feet

Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection is composed of 14 issues of a newspaper periodical entitled "The Family Casket." The periodical was published in White House Station, New Jersey, and included many stories of local interest including family doings and social occasions. This collection would interest anyone researching families or events in the White House Station area between 1868-1874.

Context:

Administrative / Biographical history: The Family Casket was a small local newspaper published in White House Station, New Jersey, between 1868-1874. It was a weekly newspaper published by A.J. Shampanore, Editor and Publisher. According to the sub-masthead, the newspaper was "An Independent Family Newspaper, Devoted to Agriculture, Science, Amusement, and Local and General Intelligence." The newspaper published many stories on local events, family matters, and noted births, deaths, and marriages. It is a prized source of information for genealogists of Hunterdon County, New Jersey.
