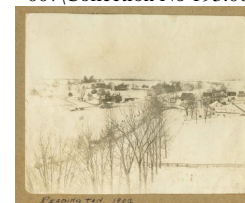

Scope & Content / Abstract:

Scope & Content:

The contents of this Readington Township collection are contained in 4 boxes consisting of 133 folders divided into 8 series.
 Series 1: Copies of justice of the peace docket, tax rateables, chancery records, deeds & indentures, vital records.
 Series 2: The places of worship in Readington Township; Readington Reformed Church Anniversary Bulletins.
 Series 3: Body & Soul - physician's daybook of smallpox vaccinations; temperance society minutes.
 Series 4: Cole Family - bible records; various ephemera including autograph book and calling cards.
 Series 5: Various promotional pamphlets and brochures, including Solberg Airport opening, village stone houses.
 Series 6: Newspaper clippings.
 Series 7: Correspondence; programs of entertainment.
 Series 8: Photographs - original and copies, including postcards.

Abstract:

Contents include books, manuscripts, photocopies of research materials and notes, postcards, photographic images, pamphlets, programs, ephemera, news clippings, minutes, diaries, and other materials related to individuals, churches, businesses, and other groups in Readington Township, NJ, ca. 1807-2005.

Most of this material was given to the donor by three Readington personalities: Elizabeth Rockafellow Disborough (the donor's Great-Aunt); Edith Wyckoff Dalrymple, the daughter of the Rev. B.V.D. Wyckoff (minister of the Readington Reformed Church); and Lorena Cole Vincent.

Of particular note are the many fine images of Readington personalities from the nineteenth century, and several records of the Readington Reformed Church from 1807-1830.

Custodial history: This collection was donated in 2015 by Fred Sisser III. The material includes a collection of books, papers, manuscripts, photocopies, postcards, files, and photographs concerning Readington Township, Hunterdon County, which was collected by Mr. Sisser since the 1960's. A majority of the primary source material came to Mr. Sisser by way of three Readington Township natives: his Great-Aunt, Elizabeth (Rockafellow) Disborough; Edith (Wyckoff) Dalrymple, the daughter of the Rev. B.V.D. Wyckoff (minister of the Readington Reformed Church); and Lorena (Cole) Vincent, an eminent historian of Readington Township.
