**Scope & Content / Abstract:**

This collection consists of account books and receipts of Aaron van Doren and David Lowe, as well as a "ciphering" book of David Lowe dated 1833. Lowe and van Doren farmed in the Barley Sheaf section of Readington Township in the mid-19th century. In addition, the collection includes a hand drawn survey map of the Choyce Farm in Bethlehem and Kingwood Townships from 1797. The collection would be of use to anyone interested in Readington Township, 19th century farming and 19th century education.
