Abstract: This collection is comprised of genealogical & geographical notes and research by Austin LaBarre Davison, Jr. (1909-1991). It includes original deeds, mortgages, articles of agreement, correspondence and ephemera concerning the Reading, Howell, Rittenhouse, Case, Scarborough and related families, primarily from the mid-18th to mid-20th centuries. Mr. Davison was the nephew of C. Lloyd Fell, a former county clerk and recorder of deeds in Hunterdon County for 17 years. Mr. Davison & Mr. Fell were descendants of the forenamed families.
