**Identity Statement:**

Title: Records of the Fannie B. Abbott Student Loan Foundation

**Scope & Content / Abstract:**

This collection contains records of the Fannie B. Abbott Student Loan Foundation, an organization that granted student loans to Hunterdon County public high school graduates attending colleges. The records include by-laws, application forms, Trustee lists and resignations, and meeting minutes from the years 1968 to 1996. This collection would interest any researcher of Hunterdon County schools and student aid programs.

**Context:**

Administrative / Biographical history: The Fannie B. Abbott Student Loan Foundation was established in memory of Fannie B. Abbott, the Clerk of Raritan Boro and a longtime advocate of education in Hunterdon County. The Foundation was created to grant loans to Hunterdon County Public High School graduates who wanted to go to college and pursue a career in teaching or a related field.

The Foundation received funding through contributions made by Hunterdon County PTA groups and individuals. The Foundation helped varying amounts of students each year, depending on available funds, student need, and student eligibility.
