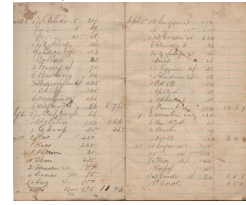

Identity Statement:

Title: Hampton Family Ledgers and Diaries
 Extent of the unit of description: 2 boxes; 1 linear foot

Scope & Content / Abstract:

Abstract: This collection consists of ledgers and account books from Morris Hampton and from other various merchants. Also included are a church guest register, a diary, and a scrapbook, along with miscellaneous papers found inside these books. Most of these items are from the area of Quakertown, Hunterdon County, and the items date between 1855 - 1925.

Scope and content: The majority of the account books and ledgers in this collection belonged to Morris Hampton of Quakertown, N.J. and cover the dates 1855 - 1903. These items reflect the cost of goods during this time period as well as showing relationships between merchants in the Hunterdon County area. Other items of note in this collection include the scrapbook created by Rebecca Clifton Hampton (1844-1857), and an order book used as a diary by Lara Davenport of Quakertown dated 1896 and covering events into 1925.

Access conditions: Manuscript collections may only be viewed at the Hiram E. Deats Memorial Library. The Hiram E.
