Abstract: This collection consists of ledgers and account books from Morris Hampton and from other various merchants. Also included are a church guest register, a diary, and a scrapbook, along with miscellaneous papers found inside these books. Most of these items are from the area of Quakertown, Hunterdon County, and the items date between 1855 - 1925.

Scope and content: The majority of the account books and ledgers in this collection belonged to Morris Hampton of Quakertown, N.J. and cover the dates 1855 - 1903. These items reflect the cost of goods during this time period as well as showing relationships between merchants in the Hunterdon County area.
