Abstract: This collection is comprised of twenty photographs from the office of the Hunterdon County Democrat. Some of the images were published, some were unpublished, but most of the images have dates and identifying remarks on the verso. The images are mostly of the Flemington area, with a few scattered images from other county sites. The photographs are roughly dated ca. 1865-1968, and although it is a small collection, its eclectic nature and random imagery capture a unique representation of Hunterdon County.
