**Scope & Content / Abstract:**

This small collection is comprised of seven photographic images of the Shaw family from Hunterdon County, NJ. They lived "between Readington and Raritan" as it is stated on the verso of two of the images. The images are roughly dated from 1860-1880 based upon the style of dress and the photographic process used to create them. Any researcher or descendant of the Shaw family from Hunterdon County would likely find these photographs interesting.
