Identity Statement:

Title: Case Family Photographs
 Extent of the unit of description: 2 boxes; 1 linear ft.

Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection spans four decades and consists of photographs of certain portions of the Case family from Hunterdon County, NJ. The images are dated ca. 1900-1946. They depict members of the family in terms of children's portraits, parents, and family groups.

The images in this collection center mostly on family groups. Prominently featured are Leslie and Sadie Case, and their children Fred and Aliston; Willette, Barb, and Rectford, Jr. (the children of Rectford Case); and Fred and Nellie Case and their son Pierson Case. In addition, there are other images of unidentified individuals who may be Case relations or are images of people already pictured at significantly different ages. There are also some images of non-family members important to the family.

This collection is an important resource for those descendants of the Case family doing genealogical research.
