Name of Creator: Frederick Alles

Administrative / Biographical history: Frederick A. Alles was born on 4 September 1923. He was the son of Harry Marshall Alles and Arietta Quick Alles of Flemington, and husband of Eva Fleck Alles.

He lived most of his life in New Jersey. He was a vice president of the Somerset Savings Bank and manager of its Flemington office. After retiring from banking, he had a successful career in real estate. He was a graduate of Flemington High School, class of 1941, and a member of Darcy Lodge, F.&A.M., Flemington. He was an active member of Three Bridges Reformed Church, serving as a Sunday School teacher, deacon and elder.

He participated in a variety of sports, including football, baseball, track and field, and golf. He was a founding member of the Flemington Plow Jockeys, a semi-professional football team in the mid to late 1940's.

Upon his retirement, Frederick Alles relocated to Warminster, Maryland. He donated this collection of materials to the Society in 1997. Frederick Alles died on 21 October 2011.
