Identity Statement:

Title: Race Family Photographic Album

Extent of the unit of description: 1 box; .5 linear feet

Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection consists of the photographic contents of a family photographic album. Most of the images appear to be from the Race and allied families of Hunterdon County, N.J., and most of the images appear to be from ca. 1860 - 1918. Aside from the Race family (Paul, Henry, Henry Race Jr., Ida, Effie, Mary Ellen, Anna), the most common surname in the photographs appears to be the Woodruffs (Araminta, Frank, Ann, Lulu, Emma) and other families (Huber, McClellan, Fitts, etc.). This collection would of course interest anyone researching the genealogy of the Race and allied families of Hunterdon County.

Context:

Administrative / Biographical history: This photographic album was originally donated to the Historical Society as part of the Emley-Race Collection, Manuscript Collection 26. Dr. Henry Race, a founding member of the Historical Society, was the donor of the collection. The original collection was arranged and described in the 1980's by Reverend George Kreutler, the Society's Manuscript Curator. The album was assigned a photograph number and added to the photograph collection.

A closer inspection of the album revealed a collection of photographs that were in fine condition and had a good degree of identification. Therefore, the album was disbound and the photographs individually cataloged as a separate collection. The actual creator of the album is unknown, but the inclusion of a cartoon drawing of Mrs. A.S. W. Race as an older woman working on a photographic document is a strong indicator that she may have been the creator. The date of creation of the album is also unknown. Most of the photographs are clearly from the era of 1860-1900; but there are a few additions toward the end from 1918. It is possible these were added later after the bulk of the album had been created; there were some empty pages in the rear of the album.
