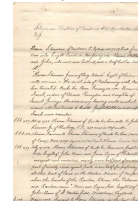

This collection consists of correspondence, family records, deeds, bible records, mortgages, and genealogical records. It appears that most of the families within this collection have some relationship to the tract of land owned by Frank Jala called Jala Farm in Bethlehem Township. While the blueprint of the property is not included there is a hand drawn map attached to the "research Notes of Deed Searches: Land Parcels" These records list the particulars of land transactions.

A.C. Hulsizer was the Jala attorney and there is a file of correspondence with Michael A. Coviello, a New York Attorney.
