Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection consists of approximately 50 photographs and images of New Germantown, NJ (now Oldwick) and surrounding areas. Many of the photographs are in the village, with a few of the country scenes toward Fairmont to the North. The donor's notations on the back of most of the photographs provide identification and occasional informational anecdotes. According to local residents, many of the buildings identified in the images are still present in 2022. This collection would interest any researcher of New Germantown, NJ (Oldwick, Tewksbury Township) or of northern Hunterdon County.

Administrative / Biographical history: Marion Waldron, buried 1/19/1997 at age 98, and Helen Waldron, buried 13/1996 at age 94, were lifelong residents of New Germantown/Oldwick. They were the daughters of William and Margaret Craig Waldron and lived their entire life on their inheritance.

Both sisters were long time members and donors of the Hunterdon County Historical Society. Marion's estate provided a generous donation to the Society as well as a number of historical items.
