Scope & Content / Abstract:

Records of Ryman Herr, Attorney for Readington Township and the Readington Township Board of Education, 1950-1959. Includes records relating to Three Bridges, Stanton, Cold Brook, and Ridge Schools.

Scope and Content: A collection of papers amassed by Ryman Herr during his time as attorney for the Township of Readington and the Readington School District. These documents include correspondence and legal instruments concerning the sale of school properties within the district, as well as the management of alterations and construction made during the same time. The folders of the collection are divided by the school building or property to which they pertain.

 Name of Creator: Ryman Herr
 Administrative / Biographical history: Charles Ryman Herr was born in Flemington in 1891. He served in the Army during the First World War, and was decorated for his service in France. He attended Michigan State University for undergraduate college and then graduated from Columbia University Law School. With his law degree, he would work as an attorney and partner at Herr & Fisher, in Flemington, for roughly 50 years. Ryman Herr would also go and serve on the Board of Directors for the First National Bank of Milford as well as the Crystal Ice & Coal Company of Somerville. Herr passed away at age 81 in 1973.
