With his law degree, he would work as an attorney and partner at Herr & Fisher, in Flemington, for roughly 50 years. Ryman Herr would also go and serve on the Board of Directors for the First National Bank of Milford as well as the Crystal Ice & Coal Company of Somerville. Herr passed away at age 81 in 1973.
