### Scope & Content / Abstract:

This collection includes the photographic proofs, prints, and contacts that make up the images printed in the text of the book, "A History of East Amwell, 1700-1800" published by the East Amwell Bicentennial Committee in 1976. In addition, there is another set of images not included in that book that are a separate grouping, and these include images of the Flemington Carnival Parade in 1912 as well as other images. Taken together, this is an important set of visual documentary history for both East Amwell and Flemington, NJ.

Box 1: Photographs arranged according to ascending coordinating page numbers in "A History of East Amwell, 1700-1800."

Box 2: Photographs arranged according to ascending coordinating page numbers in "A History of East Amwell, 1700-1800," continued.
