Abstract: This collection contains legal documents relating to property owned by Donald B. Anderson and his wife Eleanor. Also included are three photographs. This collection would be of interest to those researching property records in Flemington in the 1950s and 1960s.

Scope and Content: The materials in the collection include a 1951 mortgage to Donald and Eleanor Anderson for a property on Mine Street in Flemington, a 1961 deed to the couple from the Flemington-Raritan Board of Education for a property on Bonnell Street in Flemington, and a 1961 abstract of title for the same property. Also included are three photographs: one of Willis Carver in front of Carver Auto Parts Store in Flemington, and two of Charles Burkett with his dog.
