Frank Podayko was a Russian immigrant who initially moved to America in the 1910s and fought as part of the U.S. Army during World War I. Frank Podayko would eventually meet Lukeria (Lucy) Lozowska and the pair were married in Dywin, Poland in 1921, when Frank was 26 and Lucy was 18. They were married under the names of Jewrem (Frank) Podajko and Lukeria (Lucy) Lozowska. The ceremony was presided over by the Reverend Mikolaj Pietrowski and Cantor Nina Zukowska. In 1922, after the birth of their first child, John Podayko, in Dywin, Poland the couple moved to the United States. The Podaykos had their second child, Irene Podayko, in New York in 1929, and finally settled in Hunterdon County, New Jersey in 1930. John Podayko died in 1979, leaving behind both his surviving parents and younger sister, Irene. Frank Podayko died in

September 1989; his wife Lucy followed him 3 months later passing away in December of 1989. Irene Podayko passed away at the Hunterdon Medical Center on February 25th. 2010.
