Description Scope and Content: The twenty-two photographs depict scenes inside and outside the Hunterdon County Courthouse including those of the lead defense attorney Edward J. Reilly, Reilly and Hauptmann at the defense table, the wooden ladder, and of Charles A. Lindbergh, Sr. entering the courtroom. The photographs were acquired by the Society through purchase from a local antique dealer.

Abstract: Collection consists of twenty-two photographs of various scenes from the trial of Bruno Hauptmann. The photographs do not provide complete coverage of the trial but give a general overview of different events surrounding, and within, the courthouse. The photographer is unknown.
