Description Abstract: This collection is comprised of documents relating to the service records and biographical information concerning Hunterdon County Revolutionary War soldiers. The majority of the soldiers in this collection were included in the U.S. Revolutionary War Pensioner Census of 1840. The folders are a mix of original notes, research, and copies of information from other primary and secondary sources. The collection would interest anyone conducting biographical or genealogical research on Hunterdon County Revolutionary War Soldiers.

Scope and Content: This collection is arranged in 37 folders of documents in two containers. Folders 2 to 36 contain notes on one soldier and his family (Three folders document more than one soldier of that surname.) Folder 1 is background information and Folder 36 contains data on a number of soldiers. The folders contain service records, war pension applications and records, family genealogical notes, and in some cases wills, obituaries, grave site information, and news clippings. The folders are arranged alphabetically but are also numbered according to the container list for ease of access.
