Administrative Biographical History

Frank Ellsworth Burd (1890-1985) was a member of the H.C.H.S. from 1910 until his death in 1985, serving several terms as vice-president. He was born in Quakertown, N.J., on 1 August 1890, to Leonard G. and Mary Woodruff Burd. He attended local schools and graduated from the Readington Academy in 1911. He began his teaching career in a one-room school house in Stanton, then in became principal of schools in Watchung and Pattenburg. In 1921, he moved to South Bound Brook, where he served as superintendent of schools until his retirement when he returned to Hunterdon County. Mr. Burd assisted in keeping the Society's library; served on the Society's obituary committee writing brief life histories of many society members; wrote early reminiscences, observations, traditions, and stories remembered from childhood; copied and compiled newspaper obituaries

and marriages notices, and compiled the "Marriage Records of Hunterdon County, 1876-1900, Vol. II". Frank Burd married Florence Parks on 24 Dec 1914. They had one son, Carroll (1918-1920) and a daughter, Mrs. Margery Burd Grover. Mr. Burd served as a Sunday School teacher at the Amwell Church of the Brethren near his home in Delaware Township for 15 years. Florence Burd died on March 30, 1963. Frank Ellsworth Burd died Aug. 5, 1985, at the age of 85 and is buried in the Locust Grove Cemetery. -HCHS Centennial Newsletter Series, Fall 1985
