**Description** Collection of scrapbooks, photographs albums, and autograph albums compiled by Josie Sherry during the mid 1930s and early 1940s. One of the autograph albums is a mixture of her classmates and individuals from the Lindbergh-Hauptmann Trial. Some of these autographs include Anna Hauptmann, Jack Benny, Damon Runyon, Dorothy Kilgallen, David Wilentz, and Edward Reilly. There is also an autograph and a sketch from Paul Frehm, one of the cartoonists who was covering the trial. The other scrapbooks and photograph albums are pictures of Josie's family and friends in Flemington and the surrounding areas. There are also a collection of newspaper clippings about cycling, especially Charlie Jaeger and the Somerville Velodrome.

This collection would interest those who are interested in life during the Lindbergh-Hauptmann Trial as well as life in Hunterdon County in the 1930s and early 1940s.
