Description Material concerning the USS Hunterdon County, a World War II LST (Landing Ship, Tank) recommissioned by the United States Navy for service in Vietnam and later leased and eventually sold to Malaysia.

The collection includes a scrapbook containing a photograph of the USS Hunterdon County, a synopsis of the ship's history, and newspaper articles about the ship's use during Vietnam. The collection also includes declassified records from the U.S. Navy and a second photograph of the ship donated by the Hunterdon County Democrat. This material would be of use to those interested in US Naval history and ships, and the USS Hunterdon County in particular.
