Description This collection consists of 23 glass plate negatives and 38 photographic prints and negatives from the collections of the Rutgers University Museum of Agriculture. The Museum closed in 2011 and its collections were dispersed in 2014.

Box 1 contains glass plate negatives from the collections of the NJ Agricultural Experiment Station. This collection, which included thousands of glass plates, documented experiments of NJAES staff, field trips, and farms and farming life in NJ. Locations include an orchard near High Bridge, Hunterdon County, a farm in Annandale, NJ, and views of Clinton, NJ. 23 negatives, 1908-1919.

Box two contains two series of photographic prints and negatives from a collection of images documenting farm machinery and use at various farms throughout NJ. One series of prints is from Mulhocaway Farm, Clinton Township, Hunterdon County. 26 images, 1952-1956. The other series of prints is from Rosemont Farms, Rosemont, Hunterdon County. 13 images, 1959.
