Description	Lequear Family photographs and prayer book. Photographs, mostly unidentified, circa 1900. Prayer book published 1795.		



This is a collection of 17 photographs and one prayer book. This collection would interest researchers looking into the Lequear family and Hunterdon County families.

The contents of this collection is as follows. It contains one small prayer book, which belonged to Elizabeth Lequear. The bulk of this collection is composed of photographs, primarily of the Lequear family. Wilmer and Ella Lequear are identified in one photograph, and Kate Lequear is identified in another. Four photographers/studios are credited across all 17 photos: "Lee" in Phillipsburg, N.J., Frank Z. Fritz in Lambertville, N.J., W.A. Beckett, and Royal Studio in Newark, N.J. Of these 17 photos, one is oversized.
