Description This collection contains identified photographs of several members of the interrelated Servis, Sutphin, and Brewer families from the period of about 1850 to 1900, as well as a set of enlarged and labelled photographs of many historic buildings in Ringoes. It also includes many photographs of unidentified individuals from the same period. The collection would be of interest to those researching the Servis, Sutphin, or Brewer families, as well as to someone studying the history of the town of Ringoes.

Dates of Creation	Administrative Biographical History	Jacob Servis (1826-1892) was a long-time resident of Lambertville, where he and his wife Eliza operated a dry goods store on Union Street. Eliza was the daughter of Derrick Sutphin (1804-1878) and his wife Mary of Ringoes. Eliza was a dressmaker and milliner, who advertised her establishment in the Lambertville Press as "The Oldest Established Millinery Store." Jacob's brother Joseph operated a grocery store adjoining Jacob's dry goods store on Union Street. Both Jacob and Eliza Servis died in 1892, within days of each other. Eliza Sutphin Servis's sister Catherine married Peter Brewer (1830-1905), son of William Brewer and Eliza Young. Peter and Catherine had children Abraham Sutphin, Cornelia (Cora), and Ella (Nell) Brewer. Jacob Servis was one of the sixteen Hunterdon County residents who

founded the Hunterdon County Historical Society in 1885. He reputedly had an extensive collection of historical items including old and rare books in his home, which he displayed to other members of the Society, but the disposition of those items after his death is unfortunately unknown. His and his wife's estates were administered by her nephew Abraham Sutphin Brewer.
