Description 9 Photographic Images, including 1 daguerreotype, 4 ambrotypes, 2 albumen prints, 2 developed (re)prints. All photos are portraits, including members of the Risler and Bonnell families. Seven of the nine images are in decorative frames. Four subjects are identified: Ella Margaret Risler, Daniel Risler, Samuel L. Bonnell, Helen Mae Bonnell. Other subjects are unidentified, no photos are dated; year range is an estimate.

This collection would be of interest to people researching the Risler and Bonnell families, or people interested in different photographic types of the 19th century.
