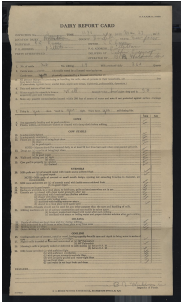

Description	This collection includes artifacts from John C. LaRue, who owned a farm in Pittstown, NJ in the late 19th century, and artifacts of Lloyd LaRue's farm in the mid-20th century. Includes ledgers and information about the farm, which included dairy cattle and some crops. Also includes a ledger from the Cooks Cross Roads School that appears to be records of a dry goods store and a ledger of farming expenses (recorded in 'The Farmer's Pocket Ledger') for the LaRue farm from 1951. Has a large number of bills for utilities, milk delivery, and vet services from the Hunterdon Hills Animal Hospital. Also includes large photograph; gathering at a church, church anniversary, 1730-1930. Photograph dated 1930 by Greisamer, Flemington.
