- Label your entry this way: **Lastname_Firstname_Title.file-extension (doc, jpg, pdf, mp4)**
Example: Smith_James_WhereWashingtonSleptInHunterdon.doc
- Essays must be 800 to 1,200 words. Other written entries should be a reasonable length for the genre.
- Photos of art projects should not exceed 3 MB. Photos should be 300 dpi and not exceed 1200 pixels on any side. Use a plain, light-colored background to photograph projects. Do not include frames on photos of artwork.
- Video files should not exceed 100GB.
- Email – as attachments – your application form (including parent permission and contact details), author or artist statement, and your written work or photo of your art project to hunterdonhistorychallenge@gmail.com.
