Administrative Biographical History Hiram Deats (1810-1887) was an American businessman known for manufacturing agricultural equipment and stove castings. Deats became the first millionaire in Hunterdon County. Hiram Deats was the son of John and Ursilla Barton Deats. In his early years, Deats worked in the shoemaker's trade near Flemington. He began the manufacture of plows at Quakertown, NJ in 1831, added stoves in 1841, which business was transferred to Stockton in 1852. The same year he added a factory/foundry and the entire business was transferred from Quakertown to Stockton. In 1860, he began the manufacture of reapers and mowers. He formed a partnership with William Case in 1863, which became Deats, Case & Co., with partners Hiram Deats, Lemuel M. Deats, William J. Case, and Rutan Case. There is also indication he at one time had a partnership with Higgins trading as Deats and Higgins. Hiram Deats was either sole proprietor or senior partner for fifty years, from 1831 to 1

April 1881. Mr. Deats married Rebecca Higgins of Hillsborough, Somerset Co., on Nov. 10, 1838. They had 4 children, Jonathan H., Emley Ogden, Lemuel Madison, and Rebecca Julia. His first wife died in 1862, and Hiram Deats married Elmira Stevenson of La Salle Co., Illinois with whom he had one son, Hiram E. Deats in 1870.
