Description Abstract: This collection consists of 190 8" x 10" black and white photographs of churches in Hunterdon County, professionally mounted on 11" x 14" mats. Taken by Frank L. Greenagel in 1997 and 1998, the photos were eventually published in a book by Greenagle entitled 'The New Jersey Churchscape: Encountering Eighteenth and Nineteenth Century Churches' (2001, Rutgers University Press).

Scope and Content: Eight boxes of 8" x 10" black and white photographs of churches in Clinton, Flemington, Frenchtown, Hillsborough, Kingwood, Lambertville, Pittstown, Whitehouse, and various other Hunterdon County municipalities. This collection would be of value to those interested in church histories and architecture in Hunterdon County, especially the various architectural styles used for churches in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries.

Frank L. Greenagel (1939-2021) was a longtime resident of Phillipsburg, NJ. Greenagel earned his PhD. at the University of Minnesota, where he was a member of the faculty; he also taught at the University of Colorado before leaving the academic world for work as an industrial psychologist for a major conglomerate. He ultimately wound up in book publishing, as the publisher and editorial director of the Academic American Encyclopedia, a multi-

		<p>volume general encyclopedia and the first digital/online encyclopedia in the world. An accomplished photographer, he briefly studied under Ansel Adams in the 1970s and wrote several books on the architecture of New Jersey, beginning with The New Jersey Churchscape.</p>
