Description This collection contains genealogical research and photos from Ida May Ramsey of Whitehouse, NJ. Common surnames mentioned throughout include Ramsey, Haver, Schomp/Schamp, Hoffman, Stryker, and Wyckoff.

A highlight of this collection is that nearly all 92 photos, originally collected in several photo albums, were marked with names. An additional bonus is the inclusion of copies of Revolutionary War Pension Application papers for 15 of Ramsey's ancestors.

This collection would be of interest to anyone researching the Ramsey family.
